Sexy, scandalous and powerful, BOMB GIRLS delves deep into the adventures of a group of women munitions workers who suddenly taste a kind of freedom they'd never dreamed of. When your overseas lover could be shot dead next month, when the materials you work with could explode in your face, when you're not sure if the free world will be even standing next month, you play your cards how you want — and you don't play by the old rules. Making bombs instead of baking pies, the women bond through their own version of trench warfare, with their own front lines and high stakes. They're living alongside male co-workers who find themselves foxes in the henhouse, equally threatened by their lipsticked co-workers, and driven to both sabotage and seduce.

"This is such a fascinating period in our history and it's a story that hasn't been told this way," said co-creator, executive producer and director Adrienne Mitchell. "It was a dynamic and fulfilling time for many women since they were contributing to the war effort, but it was also a very difficult and challenging period, as they were balancing their domestic duties and personal conflicts. I'm honoured to be setting the style and tone of the series and co-creating the show with writer/executive producer Michael MacLennan. We are thrilled to be bringing all these stories to the screen."
